Prop A Campaign Kick off!

Teaser (short sentence):

Join the grassroots campaign for a real, hopeful & winnable way to address the root causes of violence

Description (300 – 400 words max.):

Too often, we have to vote “NO” or fight to keep the few important programs we have in San Francisco. Proposition A—the “Stop Homicide Now” initiative—is different. It’s a rare chance for us to vote “YES” and put some new, inspiring programs in place. If it passes on June 6th, \$10 million each year will go to addressing systemic causes of homicide and violence in the city’s hardest-hit neighborhoods. Prop A would provide violence prevention programs, as well as employment programs for low-income young people and folks coming out of the criminal and juvenile justice systems. It would also set up and fund a taskforce of youth and adults from the communities most impacted by homicide. This taskforce would proactively address the systemic causes and impacts of homicide. The campaign for Prop A is led by mothers of young homicide victims in the Bayview and Western Addition, with allies from PowerPAC.org, the League of Pissed Off Voters, SFPO, and more. Tons of youth and community organizations are joining the campaign every day!
